- Visit the greenhouse if there is one near your place. observe how they grow plants .find out how they regulate the amount of light, water and carbon dioxide to grow the plants. Make a project file on above data
- 2. Find out what vitamins are and get the following information: Why are vitamins necessary in the diet? Which fruits or vegetables should be eaten regularly to get vitamins? Write brief note on the information collected by you on a project file. you may take help of a doctor, a dietitian, your teacher or any other person or from any other source.
- 3. Look for eggs of any moth or butterfly in a garden or park or any other place full of plants. they look like tiny dots lead in a cluster on The leaves. pull out a leaf containing eggs and place them in a cardboard box. Take some leaves of the same plant or another plant of the same variety of them and put them in the box . eggs will hatch into caterpillars which are busy eating day and night. Observe everyday and note the following:-
- (I)number of days taken for eggs to hatch
- (ii)number of days taken to reach the cocoon stage and
- (iii)number of days to complete life cycle. record your observation and make a project file.
- 4. Go to a doctor or your nearest health centre. Observe the doctor taking temperature of patients. enquire: (a)Why she dips the thermometer in a liquid before use. (b) why the thermometer is kept under the tongue. (c) whether the body temperature can be measured by keeping the thermometer at some place other than mouth. (d) whether the temperature of different parts of the body is the same or different. You can add more questions which come to your mind and make a project file.
- Collect information about the types of fuels used for cooking in your area . which fuels are less polluting and why and make a project file
- Collect information about the Indian meteorological department. If possible visit its website: http://www.imd.gov.in Write a brief report about the things that department does on a project file.
- 7. You can make your own anemometer. Collect the following items: 4 small paper cups (used icecream cups), two strips of cardboard (20 cm long and 2 cm wide), gum ,stapler a sketch pen and a sharpened pencil with eraser at one end. Take a scale; draw process on the cardboard strips as shown in the figure 8.18 in NCERT book science of class 7 this will give you the centres of the strip. Make this model and write brief about it on project file.
- 8. Make a working model of human respiratory system and write brief about it on project file.

Unseen Passage for Class7 | Passage -1

What causes the monsoon? The monsoon, which is essentially the seasonal reversal in wind direction, causes most of the rainfall received in India and some other parts of the world. The primary cause of monsoons is the difference between annual temperature trends over land and sea. The apparent position of the Sun with reference to the Earth oscillates from the Tropic of Cancer to the Tropic of Capricorn. Thus the low pressure region created by solar heating also changes latitude. The northeast and southeast trade winds converge in this low pressure zone, which is also known as the Inter tropical Convergence Zone or ITCZ. This low pressure region sees continuous rise of moist wind from the sea surface to the upper layers of the atmosphere, where the cooling means the air can no longer hold so much moisture resulting in precipitation. The rainy seasons of East Asia, sub-Saharan Africa, Australia and the southern part of North America coincide with the shift of ITCZ towards these regions.
